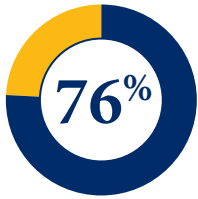

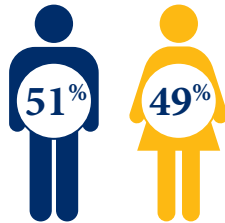

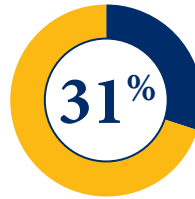
AGE

76 percent are between age 21-24. The age range is 21-37.



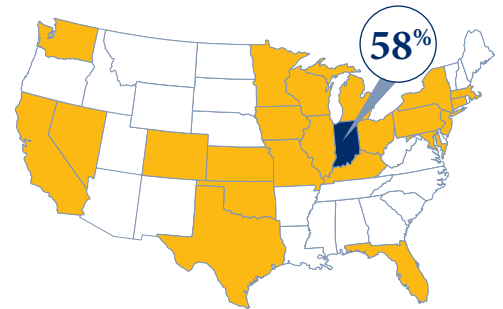
GENDER
