If this is your families first time using the Marian University’s CampMinder system to apply for a Summer Program at Marian University (MU), a parent/guardian will first need to create an account by providing their name, email, and generating a password.

If your family is returning and have previous experience with CampMinder through MU, a parent/guardian will need to use their previous account information. If one does not remember their login credentials the “Retrieve/Set Password” link can be utilized.

Once an account is created, the family will be able to sign into CampMinder to access the camp application. **When signed in, the screen will look like the image on the left.**

The information of the student who is applying to attend

the summer camp is to be entered in this screen. Once all fields are complete, the family can click the “Begin Application” button.

In the next page of the application, the family will select their camp(s) of interest. Specifically, for engineering, **select Innovation Through Engineering Camp Jun 9 – Jun 14**, as depicted in the image on the right.

Once the Summer Program is selected, the family will continue to fill out the required fields within the remaining application pages.

Once an application is complete the student will be marked as applied within the system. After a student’s application is reviewed and accepted, the student will be marked as enrolled for that Summer Program. Campers will be notified by April 14, 2024, if they are selected to attend the Innovation Through Engineering Summer Camp. Please note that tuition will be paid once a student is enrolled.
