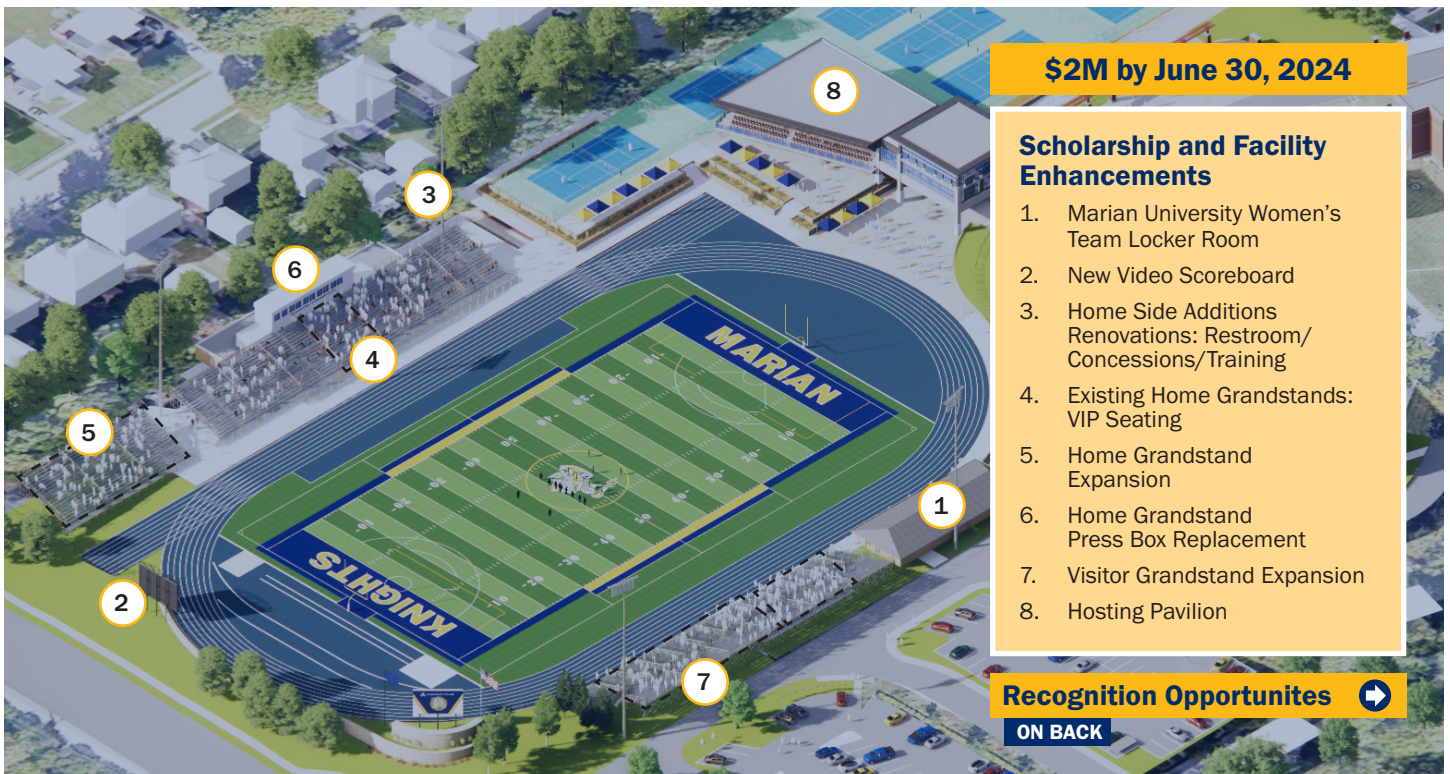
Athletics Strategic Plan Needs = **\$50M**

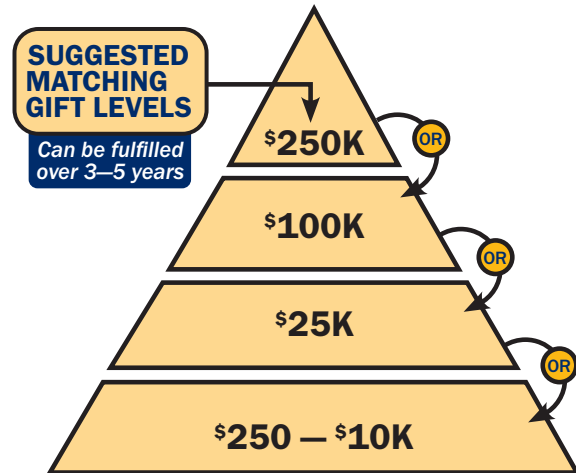
