Marian University grew out of the dedication and vision of Sister Theresa Hackelmeier and the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, Indiana, who established a school in Oldenburg, Indiana, in 1851. After a number of transformations, the school became Marian College in 1936. The college moved to Indianapolis in 1937 and classes began on September 15 in Allison Mansion.

On July 1, 2009, Marian College became Marian University. On May 4, 2011, Marian University received pre-accreditation status for a new medical school. On August 24, 2011, the university broke ground on the Michael A. Evans Center for Health Sciences that houses the Marian University College of Osteopathic Medicine and the Leighton School of Nursing. On August 6, 2013, Marian University held a ribbon-cutting ceremony and reception for the Michael A. Evans Center for Health Sciences. The College of Osteopathic Medicine matriculated its first class in August 2013 and held its inaugural commencement ceremony on May 7, 2017.



Academic Regalia

The origin of academic regalia (gowns, hoods, and caps) dates back to the 12th century when universities began to form and most scholars belonged to religious orders. Colors became standardized in the United States in 1895 when a group of leading educators from Ivy League and New York universities (the Intercollegiate Commission) introduced an Academic Costume Code (i.e., colors identify the university and degree and the cut-and-style of the academic attire distinguishes the level of education).

Gowns

Bachelor's gowns are simple with long, pointed sleeves and no trim. Master's gowns have oblong sleeves which are open at the wrist. Doctoral gowns are the most elaborate with front-facing velvet and three velvet bars on each billowing, bell-shaped sleeve.

Hoods

Bachelor regalia may include a hood which is 36 inches in length. Master's and doctoral regalia include hoods that are 42 and 48 inches in length, respectively. Hoods are

lined with silk that indicate the academic color(s) of the institution. A binding trim of velvet designates the subject in which the degree is granted. The color for doctoral degrees in medicine is green; the color was chosen to represent medieval herbs. Royal blue represents the doctoral degree in philosophy (Ph.D.).

Caps

Mortarboards are worn at all levels. Recently, tams have increasingly been adopted as the caps worn by doctoral candidates and those with a doctoral degree. Tassels are typically black or the color of the subject studied; gold tassels are worn by doctoral candidates and those with doctoral degrees. When candidates enter the ceremony, their tassels are on the right side of their cap. Graduation is signified symbolically when the tassel is moved to the left.

Michael R. Holper '85 **Commencement Speaker** Recipient of Doctor of Business

He has significant experience in the management and successful resolution of matters involving federal agencies such as the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inspector General, Department of Justice, and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.



Prior to joining Trinity Health, Holper spent 10 years with EY in Indianapolis, serving a variety of clients in the healthcare and life sciences industries, including hospitals, health systems, health insurance companies, and a global pharmaceutical manufacturer. He is a frequent industry speaker on healthcare business ethics, compliance, and auditing topics and is a key advisor to senior leadership and governance with many years of service on health system boards of directors.

Holper is a 1985 graduate of Marian University. He also received his Master of Jurisprudence in Health Law from Loyola University Chicago School of Law.

Dennis M. Murphy joined Indiana University Health (IU Health) in 2013, serving as the chief operating officer. He was named president in 2015 and chief executive officer in 2016, and has helped IU Health expand Riley Hospital for Children while enhancing patient care and efficiency gains through lean process-improvement programs across the hospital system. Under Murphy, workplace initiatives have created a more flexible, crosstrained, and culturally diverse workplace.



Throughout his career in academic health centers, Murphy has blended comprehensive patient care with medical training and research. He previously worked in administrative positions in Chicago at Northwestern Medicine, University of Chicago Medicine, and in Baltimore at The Johns Hopkins Hospital.

Murphy serves on the boards of the Indianapolis Chamber of Commerce, 500 Festival, Indiana Hospital Association, Indiana University Health Foundation, Riley Children's Foundation, Central Indiana Corporate Partnership, National Bank of Indianapolis, and Indiana Health Information Exchange. He is a member of the American Hospital Association Health Care Systems Council (AHA) and chairs the AHA's Price Transparency Task Force.

Leonard J. Betley is a retired managing partner of the law firm Ice Miller and has served as the president and chief executive officer of Fairbanks Communication, Inc., and chairman and chief executive officer of Design and Manufacturing Corporation. He has held leadership roles on multiple boards, including the president or chair of the boards of the





Richard M. Fairbanks Foundation, Regenstrief Foundation, Walther Cancer Foundation, BioCrossroads, the Regenstrief Institute, the Indiana Chapter of the Nature Conservancy, Park Tudor School, Newfields (previously known as the Indianapolis Museum of Art), the Yale Club of Indiana, and Wishard Memorial Foundation.

He is a graduate of Yale University and the University of Michigan Law School. He has received the Volunteer Fundraiser Award from the Indiana Chapter of the National Society of Fundraising Executives and The Nature Conservancy's Oak Leaf Award (the highest honor of the international Nature Conservancy), and he was celebrated as BioCrossroads' inaugural Life Sciences Champion of the Year in 2008.

Kathryn Betley graduated from DePauw University with a Bachelor of Arts in History. She was co-owner of Romancing the Seasons, a former retail store in Indianapolis. Kathryn is presently chairman of Newfields' Board of Trustees and also serves on the boards of the National Bank of Indianapolis, Butler University, Community Health Network, the Indianapolis Zoological Society, and the Indiana Chapter of Nature Conservancy.

Kathryn has received the Indianapolis Volunteer of the Year award from United Way, B'nai B'rith Woman of the Year, the Stanley K. Lacy Community Service Award, the John W. Heiney Award for Philanthropy, and the Hoosier Heritage Lifetime Achievement Award. She was also honored as one *Indianapolis Business Journal's* Most Influential Women and was inducted into the Indiana Academy.
