McKinney Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Development Grants

Eligibility

- Applicants must be full-time faculty members at Marian University.
- Funding must be utilized for new faculty-led study abroad programming.

Grants

1. Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Exploratory \$3,500

May be used to offset cost of exploratory travel when researching a program under development.

- The award must be utilized by the intended lead-faculty or shared.
- The new program being researched must be scheduled to run for the subsequent calendar year.
- Application should include a tentative program overview, schedule, and budget.

2. Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Mentorship \$2,500

May be used to offset cost of traveling with an experienced lead-faculty member on a current study abroad program and to be mentored on program management of pre/during/post activity.

- The award must be utilized by the intended lead-faculty or shared.
- The new program being researched must be scheduled to run for the subsequent calendar year.
- Application should include a tentative program overview and list of mentorship objectives.

Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Development Grant Application

This application is to be completed by faculty members who are seeking funding assistance to develop a new faculty-led study abroad program. The application must be completed by those faculty members whom will serve as “Faculty-Leaders” for the program. Grant may be utilized to offset costs for exploratory travel to program sites for one or two faculty members.

I. Eligibility

- Faculty-Leaders must be full-time employees of Marian University.
- Program being developed must be offered for credit and directly related to an academic course and/or program of study.
- Planning of a new faculty-led study abroad program should commence 12 months before the program start date.
- The Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Development Grant Application is due 9 months before the program start date.
- Grant amount for the development of a faculty-led study abroad program is \$3,500, per program.

II. Program Rationale

Please briefly respond to the following:

- How does the program fill an academic component or curricular need for your department?

- Is there an existing Marian University program that already meets these needs?

- Is there a specific reason that this program should take place in the specified location?

- Does the time of year when the program is planned appeal to students and work within their plan of study?

- Is the political/economic situation stable in the country of destination? Are there perceived health, safety or security risks? Explain.
