

McKinney Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Development Grants

Eligibility

- Applicants must be full-time faculty members at Marian University.
- Funding must be utilized for new faculty-led study abroad programming.

Grants

1. Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Exploratory \$3,500

May be used to offset cost of exploratory travel when researching a program under development.

- The award must be utilized by the intended lead-faculty or shared.
- The new program being researched must be scheduled to run for the subsequent calendar year.
- Application should include a tentative program overview, schedule, and budget.

2. Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Mentorship \$3,000

May be used to offset cost of traveling with an experienced lead-faculty member on a current study abroad program and to be mentored on program management of pre/during/post activity.

- The award must be utilized by the intended lead-faculty or shared.
- The new program being researched must be scheduled to run for the subsequent calendar year.
- Application should include a tentative program overview and list of mentorship objectives.

3. Faculty-Led Study Abroad Program Promotion \$500

May be used by lead-faculty member for promotion and marketing of a new faculty-led study abroad program.

- The award must be utilized by the intended lead-faculty or shared.
- Application should include a brief program marketing plan with key dates.
- The marketing plan should make reference of how the funds would be spent.
