

CLINICAL ADMISSION INFORMATION - TRADITIONAL BSN

- Applicants must first be admitted to Marian University. Upon admission, students must meet academic requirements to become a nursing student.
- Students will complete application to the clinical rotation and be ranked based on the Decision Tree.
- Number of students accepted into clinical is based on availability of faculty resources and clinical sites.

Admission to all programs is competitive and based on the following criteria:

DECISION TREE – TRADITIONAL TRACK

Minimum admission requirements include:

- Marian University cumulative GPA of 2.80
- All required pre-requisite and general education courses successfully completed (letter grade C or higher)
- Science credits or transfer equivalents (chemistry, anatomy, physiology, and microbiology) may be no older than seven (7) years at the time of the admission to the University
- Successful completion of NSG 129 offered by Marian University with a grade of C+ or higher
- Application completed in full and submitted on time

If these requirements are not met, we still encourage your application. Your application may be eligible to be reviewed through an additional process, which may require further action.

Conditional Requirements of Admission:


- Pre-requisite science GPA of 2.80 prior to nursing clinical courses
- Completion of all clinical compliance requirements
- Proof of English Language Proficiency (survey provided upon application)

Eligible applicants will then be ranked according to the following:

- Out-of-sequence students currently enrolled in Marian University 1.
- 2. Wait-listed students who applied the previous semester, but who were not awarded clinical placement based on space and still meet the minimum requirements for the current semester
- 3. Based on admission date
- Students with initial coursework at Marian University
- Transfer students will be ranked according to the number of prerequisite science or nursing course credits taken at Marian University.

Ineligible Applicants

- Applicants with two or more Marian University nursing course failures (grade less than C+ in NSG coursework)
- Transfer students from other nursing programs who have failed one nursing course within the last 5 years
- Applicants who have been previously dismissed from a nursing program
- Students who have earned a grade of less than C more than twice in the required science classes (BIO 214, BIO 225, BIO 226, CHE 100, or equivalent transferable courses)
