Key to Know: Guided Self-placement Survey in Canvas

To evaluate their own best option, each student, prior to meeting with you, should have taken a Guided Self-Placement Survey in Canvas.* This survey is designed to help students discern which First-Year Writing course structure they should register for **FIRST** to best support them as a writer.
