Honorary Degrees

Joseph S. Donnelly

Commencement Speaker

Recipient of Doctor of Public Service



Joe Donnelly was confirmed as United States ambassador to the Holy See in January 2022. The Holy See is the universal government of the Catholic Church and operates from Vatican City State, a sovereign, independent

territory. The Pope is the ruler of both Vatican City State and the Holy See. As ambassador, Donnelly consults and cooperates with the Holy See on international issues of mutual interest, including human rights, peace and conflict prevention, poverty eradication and development, environmental protection, and inter-religious understanding. He works to support a positive relationship that serves to amplify a global message of peace, freedom, and justice. Donnelly's important work in global engagement leverages the impact and network of the Vatican, extending to more than 1.3 billion Catholics and millions of non-Catholics, to promote our common priorities in every region of the world.

Prior to becoming ambassador to the Holy See, Donnelly represented Indiana in the United States Senate from 2013 to 2019, and the United States House of Representatives from 2007 to 2013. While in the House of Representatives, Congressman Donnelly helped sponsor and pass some of the most far-reaching legislation to improve veterans' health care and benefits in the history of our country.

Donnelly graduated from the University of Notre Dame in 1977 and the University of Notre Dame Law School in 1981.

During his time in Congress, Donnelly received, among other awards, the Distinguished Service Medal from the United States Navy (the Navy's highest civilian award) for his efforts on behalf of America's Naval Services. He is a past recipient of the Medal of Merit from the National Guard Association of the United States, and the Legislator of the Year from the Disabled American Veterans (2013) and Indiana Veterans of Foreign Wars (2008). Additionally, Donnelly is a founding partner of the Library of Congress' Veterans' History Project.

Donnelly lives in Granger, Indiana, with his wife, Jill. They have two children and one granddaughter.

Fred S. and Judy L. Klipsch

Recipient of Doctors of Philanthropy



Fred and Judy Klipsch have enjoyed tremendous achievements in building successful and highly respected businesses. They are now generously investing their experiences, time, talent, and treasure in education.

Following their outstanding business accomplishments, including the acquisition of multiple healthcare companies, the Klipsches purchased Klipsch Group, Inc., a small premium boutique domestic loudspeaker company, in 1989. Over the next 22 years, Fred worked as chairman and chief executive officer to expand the company's product offering to include only high-performance products for listening to music and movies, eventually becoming the number one high-performance line sold in the United States and a global market leader. Judy served the company as vice chairman, focusing on the development of the Klipsch brand message and increasing the brand image of Klipsch among its competition. By 2005, the Klipsch Group had offices in Paris, France and Shanghai, China and in 2011, was sold to VOXX International.

Prior to the sale of Klipsch Group, Fred became a leader in the Educational Choice Charitable Trust in the late 1990s. When he became chairman of the Trust, he led the effort to broaden and intensify the state of Indiana's commitment to ensure all families, especially those from economically disadvantaged homes, had access to a school of their choice. He has since served as chairman and founder of Hoosiers for Quality Education, founder of the Institute for Quality Education, and currently as chairman of the Board of Directors of EdChoice. Collaborating with political and business leaders, as well as education activists, Fred has worked to enact a series of major legislative initiatives including the expansion of educational choice through the establishment of a voucher program, tax credit scholarships, education savings accounts, and charter schools. He has also played a key role in advancing compensation approaches for teachers that rewards their contributions to students, K-12 academic standards, and accountability.

Fred Klipsch earned his bachelor's degree from Purdue University in 1964 and his MBA from California State University at Long Beach in 1968. He also served as an officer in the United States Airforce from 1964-1968. Judy Klipsch earned two bachelor's degrees from Ball State University. In 2017,

Judy Klipsch established the Judy L. Klipsch Angel Educators scholarship fund in support of Marian University students who she calls Angels — teachers who make a difference in the lives of children. Dozens of Marian University graduates have benefitted from Judy's scholarship and now serve as teachers across Indiana. Judy also serves as an advisor to Marian University in marketing communications with a focus on elevating the university's Catholic and Franciscan identity. Fred has made remarkable contributions in providing strategic advice to Marian University as a loyal member of the Board of Trustees. Together, the Klipsches have committed more than \$10 million to Marian University's Klipsch Educators College.

Anthony R. Mason

Recipient of Doctor of Public Service



Tony Mason is a visionary leader with a passion for service. During his tenure as the president and chief executive officer of the Indianapolis Urban League (IUL), the organization has become a Center for Working

Families, expanded the Project Ready College and Career Readiness Program, increased health and wellness services, established an agency endowment fund, and secured a National Urban League Entrepreneurship Center Program designation. Mason has also been involved in the creation of the Indy Rents Program, the Business Equity for Indy Initiative, and the Corporate and Community Partners for Racial Equity now known as INSPIRE. Additionally in 2020, he helped the National Urban League secure a \$100 million grant from the Lilly Endowment to support the Indianapolis Urban League and African American

Coalition of Indianapolis' collaboration on the Indianapolis African American Quality of Life Initiative.

Prior to his tenure with the IUL, Mason served as the senior vice president of the 2012 Indianapolis Super Bowl Host Committee. He also held leadership positions with Circle City Classic, the National Collegiate Athletic Association, the Amateur Athletic Union, Indiana Black Expo, Miami University of Ohio, and Wichita State University.

Mason serves as a trustee for Ascension St. Vincent Indianapolis and Ascend Indiana, and he serves on advisory, management, and steering committees with the United Way of Central Indiana, the Greater Indianapolis Progress Committee and Race and Cultural Relations Leadership Network, the African American Coalition of Indianapolis, Regions Bank Community Development Corporation, the Indiana Sports Corporation, the Corporate and Community Partnership for Racial Equity, the Indy Inclusive Growth Collaborative, the Civic Leadership Alliance, and the Business Equity for Indy Initiative.

He has received numerous awards including the *Indianapolis Business Journal's* Forty under 40 Award and Top 250 Most Influential Business Leaders in Indiana recognition, the Center for Leadership Development's Achievement in Business Award, McDonald's Black History Maker of Today Award, the Black Coaches Association's Images of Excellence Award, the NAACP Outstanding Achievement Award, and the state of Indiana's highest civilian honor, the Sagamore of the Wabash Award.

Mason earned his undergraduate and graduate degrees from Miami University of Ohio.

He and his wife, Joy, have two sons.
