It's been a remarkable year for the society!

We are honored to share some highlights from the past year:

- Our Young Alumni Circle has taken off this year with 13 young women joining the society. This is notable as it demonstrates that our mission resonates crossgenerationally and ensures our future.
- Our friends in Plymouth launched the Women of Marian: Ancilla Chapter which honors their foundresses, the Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ, while creating opportunities for women on their campus.
- We have set new records at every event this year, and are ensuring this momentum continues into 2025! This year there was a(n):
 - 82% attendance increase at our Galentine's Celebration
 - 71% attendance increase at our Summer Luncheon
 - 112% attendance increase at our Holiday Wine Tasting
- Our endowment has grown, and thanks to being the beneficiary of the Founders Classic event, we will have more than \$500,000 in the endowment when we start fiscal year 2025-2026. This is amazing as it ensures we have the funding to realize our initial vision to support two young women in each undergraduate class. It also means we can start working on a new vision to increase that number to do even more for future women students of Marian.

Most importantly, we want to thank you for your generous gifts to the society. Because of you, we are currently reviewing applications for our 2025-2026 scholarships. The applicants are impressive young ladies who we will all be proud to support.

OUR HISTORY

The Women of Marian Society serves to honor Marian University's foundresses, the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, Indiana.

The name "Women of Marian" was originally coined for graduates of Marian College, as it served as a women's college until 1954. The first gatherings of these original Women of Marian were called "Tea on the Terrace," which was an annual social opportunity for women graduates. In 2010, this evolved into a luncheon for women stakeholders of the University.

It was in 2019 that the Women of Marian Society, as it's known now, injected philanthropy and structure into these former all-women gatherings. Since then, the organization has seen tremendous growth and significantly impacted multiple young women.
