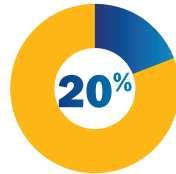

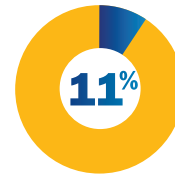

20 percent are first generation college students.

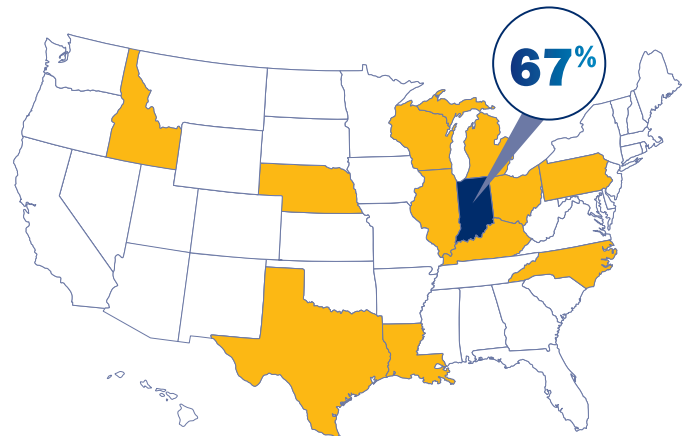


### UNDERREPRESENTED IN MEDICINE
