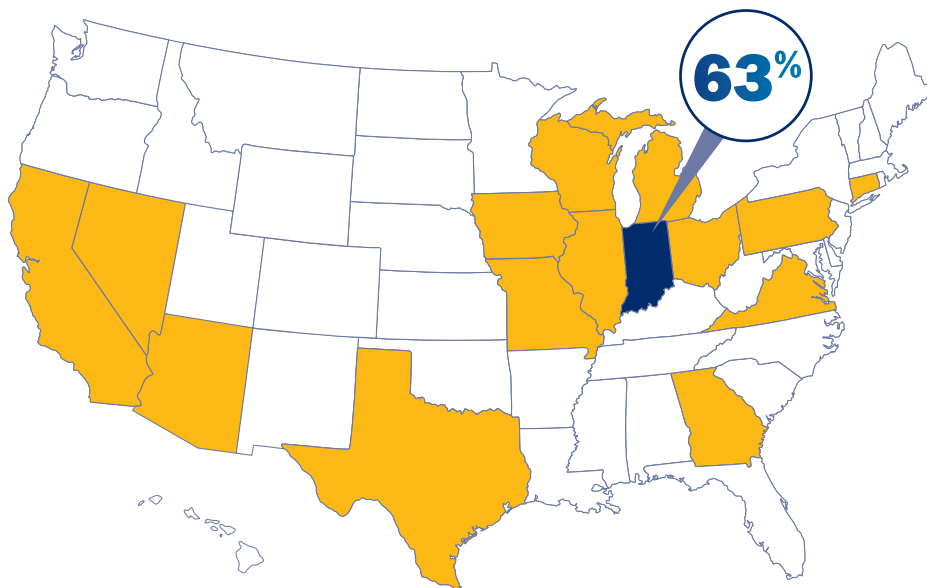

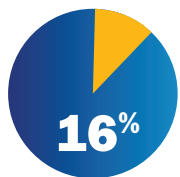
55 different undergraduate and graduate institutions are represented, including 18 from Indiana. Top institutions:

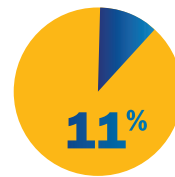
FIRST GENERATION
