Five spots under each track will be reserved for DePauw undergraduates each year. Students will have two options toward acceptance:



EARLY DECISION TRACK

Qualifications

- Graduate in the spring semester prior to possible MU-WCOM matriculation.
- Minimum total GPA of 3.70, with a minimum science GPA of 3.50.
- Minimum MCAT score of 505, with a minimum biology score of 127.
- If offered, acceptance is contingent upon maintaining grades and completing program requirements.

Benefits

- Guaranteed interview in September of senior year if application is complete.
- Guaranteed admission decision within one week of interview.

Process

- Submit application to American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Application Service (AACOMAS) to be received at MU-WCOM by July 15 before senior year.
- Submit remaining application materials to MU-WCOM by August 15 before senior year, including recommendation from DePauw.

GUARANTEED INTERVIEW TRACK

Qualifications

- Graduate in the spring semester prior to possible MU-WCOM matriculation.
- Minimum total and science GPA of 3.50.
- Minimum MCAT score of 500, with a minimum biology score of 124.
- If offered, acceptance is contingent upon maintaining grades and completing program requirements.

Benefits

- Guaranteed interview in October of senior year if application is complete.
- Guaranteed admission decision within one week of interview.
