Five spots under each track will be reserved for Benedictine University master's students each year. Students will have two options toward acceptance:



EARLY DECISION TRACK

Qualifications

- Graduate in the spring semester prior to possible MU-WCOM matriculation.
- Minimum total program GPA of 3.50.
- Minimum MCAT score of 505, with a minimum biology score of 127.
- Acceptance is contingent upon maintaining grades and completing prerequisites and conditions.

Benefits

- Guaranteed interview in September of matriculation year if application is complete.
- Guaranteed admission decision within one week of interview.

Process

- Submit application to American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Application Service (AACOMAS) to be received at MU-WCOM July 15 before matriculation.
- Submit remaining application materials to MU-WCOM by August 15 before matriculation, including recommendation from academic advisor.

Qualifications

- Graduate in the spring semester prior to possible MU-WCOM matriculation.
- Minimum total program GPA of 3.30.
- Minimum MCAT score of 498, with a minimum biology score of 124.
- Acceptance is contingent upon maintaining grades and completing prerequisites and conditions.

Benefits

- Guaranteed interview in October of matriculation year if application is complete.
- Guaranteed admission decision within one week of interview.
