Academic Regalia

The origin of academic regalia (gowns, hoods, and caps) dates back to the 12th century when universities began to form and most scholars belonged to religious orders. Colors became standardized in the United States in 1895 when a group of leading educators from Ivy League and New York universities (the Intercollegiate Commission) introduced an Academic Costume Code (i.e., colors identify the university and degree and the cut-and-style of the academic attire distinguishes the level of education).

Gowns

Bachelor's gowns are simple with long, pointed sleeves and no trim. Master's gowns have oblong sleeves which are open at the wrist. Doctoral gowns are the most elaborate with front-facing velvet and three velvet bars on each billowing, bell-shaped sleeve.

Hoods

Bachelor regalia may include a hood which is 36 inches in length. Master's and doctoral regalia include hoods that are 42 and 48 inches in length, respectively. Hoods are

lined with silk that indicate the academic color(s) of the institution. A binding trim of velvet designates the subject in which the degree is granted. The color for doctoral degrees in medicine is green; the color was chosen to represent medieval herbs. Royal blue represents the doctoral degree in philosophy (Ph.D.).

Caps

Mortarboards are worn at all levels. Recently, tams have increasingly been adopted as the caps worn by doctoral candidates and those with doctoral degrees. When master and doctoral candidates enter the ceremony, their tassels are on the left side of their cap and they do not move the tassel. When associate and bachelor candidates enter the ceremony, their tassels are on the right side of their cap and graduation is signified symbolic when the tassel is moved to the left.

Todd Huston - SpeakerState Representative Doctor of Public Service



Todd Huston of Fishers, Indiana, was first elected in 2012 as state representative for the constituents of House District 37, which includes a portion of Hamilton County. Huston was first selected by House

members to serve as Indiana House speaker in 2020, and he currently leads the 100-member chamber, including the 70-member Republican supermajority.

Huston received the 2021 Champion of School Choice Award from the Institute for Quality Education for supporting a significant expansion of Indiana's Choice Scholarship program. In 2022, Huston spearheaded the passage of a \$1 billion tax-relief package to support hardworking Hoosiers—the largest tax cut in state history.

Huston helped lead the creation of the Regional Economic Acceleration and Development Initiative (READI) in 2021 with a \$500 million investment to promote community collaboration and growth. In 2023, he supported directing another \$500 million to support READI 2.0. Through this transformative program, regions created a strong vision for the future and applied for competitive grants. In total, READI will create an economic investment of over \$13 billion for communities across Indiana.


Huston previously served on the Hamilton Southeastern School Board, Hamilton Southeastern Schools Foundation Board, Fishers Planning Commission, and Indiana Leadership Forum Board of Directors. Additionally, former Governor Mitch Daniels twice called on Huston to serve the state, first with a four-year term as a member of the Indiana State Board of Education and from 2006-09 as a member of the Indiana Education Roundtable.

Huston and his wife, Denise, reside in Fishers, Indiana, and have two adult children, Elizabeth and Jake.

He served as the founding chair of the Deans Advisory Board and as president of the medical staff of both Select Specialty Hospital and Kindred Hospital Indianapolis many times for 20 years.

Jim's civic engagements include being an ordained elder in the Presbyterian Church. He has also served as the founding medical director of Near West Free Clinic for the past seven years.

Jim's work has been recognized with an alumni service award from Kansas City University in 2013 and the Snyder-Watt Leadership Award from Marian University in 2021. He is also a member of the Gold Humanism Honor Society.
